#### SUSPENSION INSTALLATION NOTE




## **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- The use of a factory service manual is highly recommended. These can be purchased or downloaded online at http://techinfo.subaru.com.
- It's important to make sure spacers and washers are aligned properly.
- If your car is driven during winters in states that salt the roads, its important to wash off dirt and salt to ensure premature corrosion doesn't occur. An alternative is to put some heavy duty, water proof bearing grease around bearings to keep out water and dirt.
- These PERRIN Sphearical Bearing endlinks have a bearing that will eventually wear out.

## Parts Included with the PERRIN WRX Rear Endlink Kit:

- (2) PERRIN WRX rear endlinks
- (8) SS WRX Endlink Spacers
- (4) Red urethane spacers





### Removal and Installation of Endlinks

- 1. Raise vehicle off ground onto jack stands or using a professional lift.
- 2. Remove both left and right endlinks from swaybar, then from control arm. Use 14mm wreches to remove. **NOTE: Be** sure to keep **OEM bolts and washers, these will be reused.**
- 3. Using pictures for illustration, install new PERRIN end link.
  - a. Using bolts removed earlier, install endlink to swaybar making sure install spacers on both side of link as shown above. Leave bolts loose for now. **NOTE:Make sure that small side fits into bearing.**
  - b. Install remaining spacers into lower bearing on endlink. NOTE:Make sure that small side fits into bearing.
  - c. Included are (4) red urethane bushings. These bushings need to be placed over the lower endlink spacers as shown above. **NOTE: When endlink is bolted to lower control arm, these spacers help keep the endlink straight during normal suspension movement.**
  - d. Slide endlinks into control arm (between both brackets on control arm) and install OEM bolt removed earlier.
- 4. With endlinks on both sides installed ,torque nuts and bolts to 50ft/lbs. Make sure to double-check this after a few miles have been put on the endlinks.
- 5. Proceed to test drive car. If any noises are heard, double check that all (4) bolts are tightened to spec. If noise continues to occur please contact deal or PERRIN Performance.
- 6. Over time, endlink bearings will loosen up and can eventually make noise. When this happens it's a sign to replace bearing with new ones. If this happens, give our Tech department a call and we can get you taken care of.
